

Dear Farm Credit East Members,

I am asking for your vote as I run for the Western seat on the Farm Credit East Board of Directors. I was born and raised on a poultry, cash crop and fruit farm including an agribusiness in southern Delaware which is now in its 4th generation. After graduating from Cornell with an animal science degree, I worked as a farm business management agent on a Dairy Team for Cooperative Extension. After raising 4 children and being heavily involved in many school, church and community activities, I now feel I have the time, energy and enthusiasm to devote to this position as a director.

Part of my position as business manager at Amos Zittel & Sons, Inc. has been to work with Ball Seed Company and other plant brokers' sales force and customers providing customer service and shipping logistics. We have over 700 annual customers many of which I have gotten to know very well and in doing so it has helped me to understand the pulse of our industry. We grow over 950 varieties of flowers and ship over 2 million rooted liners throughout the country. In addition to customer service, I have served as comptroller and financial manager for our wholesale and retail business as well as support for our human resource team hiring over 100 employees – migrant and h2a. These experiences have provided me with a strong understanding of our agriculture industry both locally and nationally.
