## Why Do Government Agencies and Others Offer Grants?

- 1. Meets a Public Interest
- Achieves a Public Good

#### **Examples:**

Environmental Improvements

#### Grant or Incentive Assistance

First, there a few simple criteria to consider:



What is the project? What do you want to achieve?



Do you have a business plan which defines achievement?



Is the project sufficiently capitalized without grant assistance?



#### Criteria to Consider cont.

#### Then consider:



Size of the project



Development Challenges: infrastructure, resources and capital



#### Criteria to Consider cont.

#### Finally, consider:



**Timing** 



Most grants do not cover work already completed



Success = start early with business plan, budget, funding



USDA Rural Business-Cooperative Service — Value Added Agricultural Product Market Development Grant Program (VAPG)

**Purpose:** encourage producers of commodities to refine products to increase value – for feasibility studies, business and marketing plans and/or studies to establish venture

**Eligibility:** independent producers or producer associations of raw commodities

Application deadline: TBD, upon Farm Bill Approval

Funding levels: up to \$250,000 per proposal

## Value Added Producer Grant

USDA Rural Business-Cooperative Service - Rural Energy for America Program

**Purpose:** help farmers and rural businesses purchase renewable energy systems and make energy efficiency improvements, create new uses for ag products and waste

**Eligible projects:** systems that generate energy from wind, solar, biomass, geothermal sources, energy efficiency improvements-upgrade equipment or processes

**Eligibility:** producers and businesses in city/town with population under 50,000; 50% gross income from farm production; business with fewer than 500 employees and \$20 million in receipts

**Next application deadline: March 31, 2019** 

Funding levels: up to 25% of project costs, maximum grant was \$200,000 for energy efficiency; up to \$500,000 for renewable energy

## New Farmers Grants Program

- \$1,000,000 in funding
- \$50,000 max per farm
- Farming less than 10 years
- Due 01/25/2019

  - \$7,500-\$15,000/job created

#### **Utility Company Energy Efficiency Programs**

**Purpose:** Several programs offer incentives and loans for farm-waste management; improved energy efficiency; solar and wind generation; and innovative business practices for energy use.

Funding: varies with program

Last application deadline: dates vary with program

NYS DEC and NYS Dept. of Ag & Markets Water Quality Improvement Projects

**Purpose:** implement management programs, plans or projects including non-point source abatement and control (ag & non-ag), aquatic habitat restoration and pollution prevention
